| <b>Beach</b>   | The part of a shore near the sea or ocean.                            |
| <b>Cliff</b>   | A high, steep face of a rock.   |
| <b>Coast</b>   | The land next to the sea.   |
| <b>Ocean</b>   | A huge expanse of salt water – it covers three quarters of the earth! |
| <b>Port</b>    | A place where ships load or unload.                                   |
| <b>Harbour</b> | The water next to the shore where ships can dock.                     |
