| <b>Explore</b>           | To travel across or through in order to discover or search for something.                           |
| <b>Explorer</b>          | A person who explores unknown places.   |
| <b>Voyage</b>            | A long journey by air, sea, land or outer space.  |
| <b>Continent</b>         | A very large area of land   |
| <b>Ocean</b>             | A huge area of salty water  |
| <b>Discover</b>          | To find or see before anyone else.  |
| <b>Native</b>            | A person or animal who originally lived in a country  |
| <b>Navigate</b>          | To find your way around.  |
| <b>Physical features</b> | Things that you can see all around you that would still be here even if there were no people around |

## Christopher Columbus
