# More Important Words

**Bisexual:** A person who is attracted to both men and women is **bisexual**.

**Transgender:** A person who was born male, but feels like a woman, or a person who was born female, but feels like a man, is **transgender**. This can also mean a person who doesn't feel like a woman or a man.

**Queer:** **Queer** means 'different', and is another word used by some LGBT people to describe themselves.
