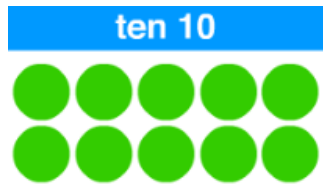


# Year 1 Key Maths Vocabulary

**Numeral:** A symbol used to represent a number. You can see the number in Roman below.

I II III IV V

**Tens:** ten ones



**Ones:** One unit

**Value:**

The amount something is worth in numbers. The value of the car is £100.



**Numberline:**



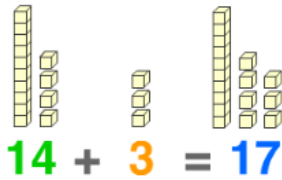
**Double:** multiplied

by 2, twice as much.  $1 + 1 = 2$    
 $2 + 2 = 4$    
 $3 + 3 = 6$

**Half:**

One of two equal parts   
 $\frac{1}{2}$

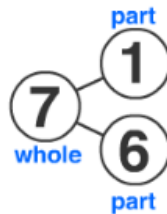
**Sum:**



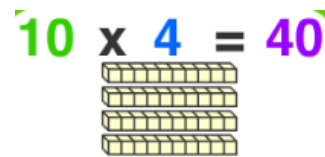
The total amount after addition.

**Number bonds**

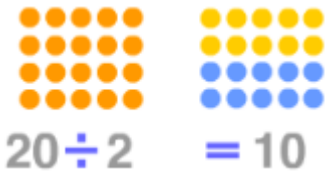
A number and the parts that combine to make it.



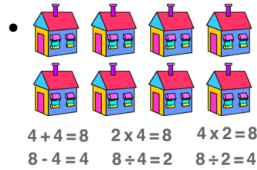
**Multiply-** where a number is added to itself a number of times.



**Divide** sharing or grouping a number into equal parts.



**Array:**



a set of objects or numbers arranged in order, often in rows and columns.

**Odd:** a number that is not divisible by 2.

**odd numbers**  
1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19



**Even:** A number that is divisible by 2.

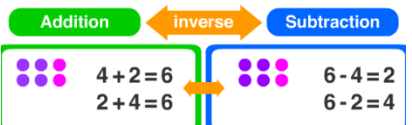
**even numbers**  
2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20



**Telling the time to O'clock and Half past**



**Inverse:** opposite



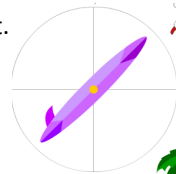
**More than**

**Whole turn:** to rotate an object around a centre point.



**Direction:** the line or course on which something is going.

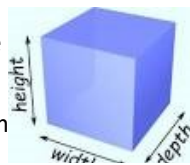


**Length and Width:**

distance across from side to side.



**Depth** the distance from the top or surface to the bottom of something.



**Metre:** the metre is the base unit of length
