# French – Year 3

1	Listen and repeat what they have heard.
2	Say a simple sentence using familiar vocabulary.
3	Describe themselves using familiar words and phrases.
4	Join in and perform repetitive phrases in chants, songs and rhymes.
5	Copy simple words (objects and key words) correctly.
6	Orally introduce themselves and respond to simple familiar questions.
7	Apply their learning by reading together a more complex story in French.
8	Describe a place using key words and phrases.

# French – Year 4

1	Listen and follow simple commands and answer questions.
2	Label items and select words to complete short sentences.
3	Describe objects using simple phrases.
4	Use modelled prepositions and pronouns.
5	Describe a place using key words and phrases
6	Identify sports and express a preference.
7	Begin to use detailed vocabulary to describe sport matches
8	The use of the verb "savoir" orally and in writing

# French – Year 5

1	Engage in simple conversations with a partner, asking and answering simple questions.
2	Write down sentences and familiar phrases using a bilingual dictionary to check spellings.
3	Describe people, places and languages special to them.
4	Use accurate pronunciation and intonation so that others understand, self-correcting as necessary.
5	Listen to and learn by heart a paragraph sharing their opinions in French.
6	Understand and compare basic grammar in written and spoken French.
7	Apply previously taught French vocabulary to a variety of role play situations.

# French – Year 6

1	Speak with increasing confidence and fluency in a range of circumstances.
2	Spelling and increasing number of words correctly in short pieces of writing.
3	Describe people, places, objects and actions orally and then apply to writing.
4	Perform and present ideas and information to a wider range of audiences.
5	Interpret simple dialogue, instructions and note down information, main points or interesting
	detail.
6	Apply grammar to their writing.
7	Learn and sing familiar French songs
